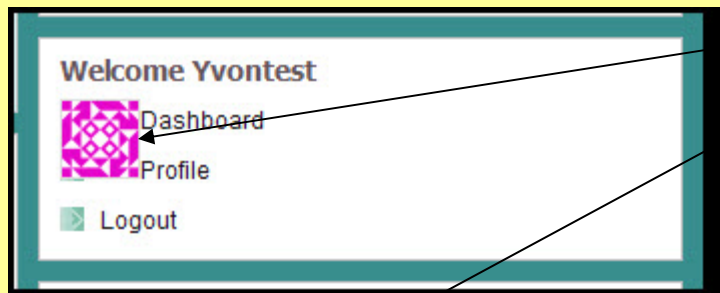
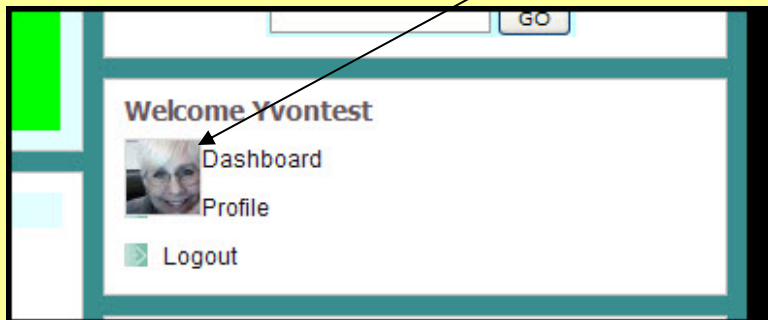


# How to create a Gravatar

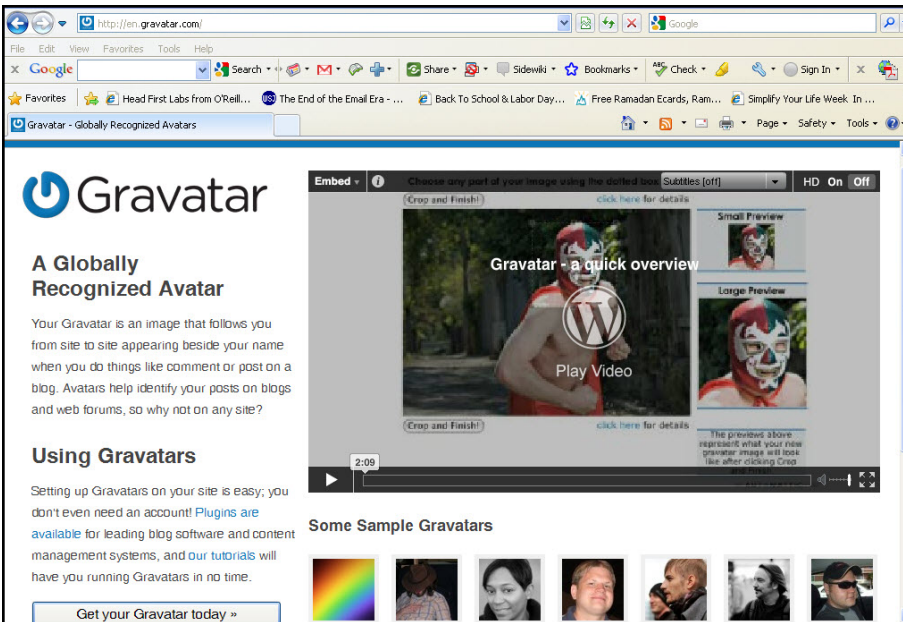


Want to go from the generic symbol to having a personalized "gravatar"?

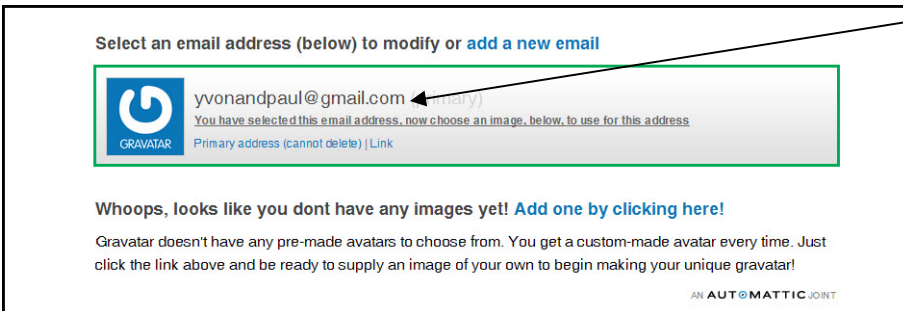
The next couple of pages will show you how! It's really EASY!



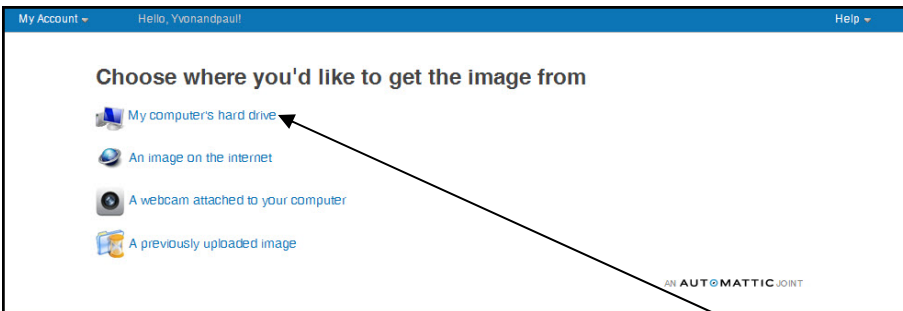

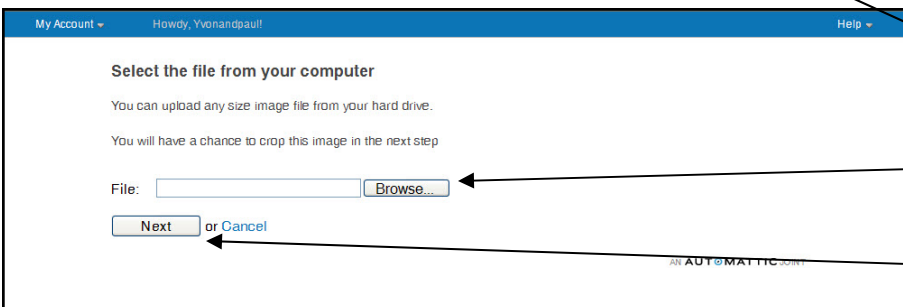
1. Go to:  
[www.gravatar.com](http://www.gravatar.com)



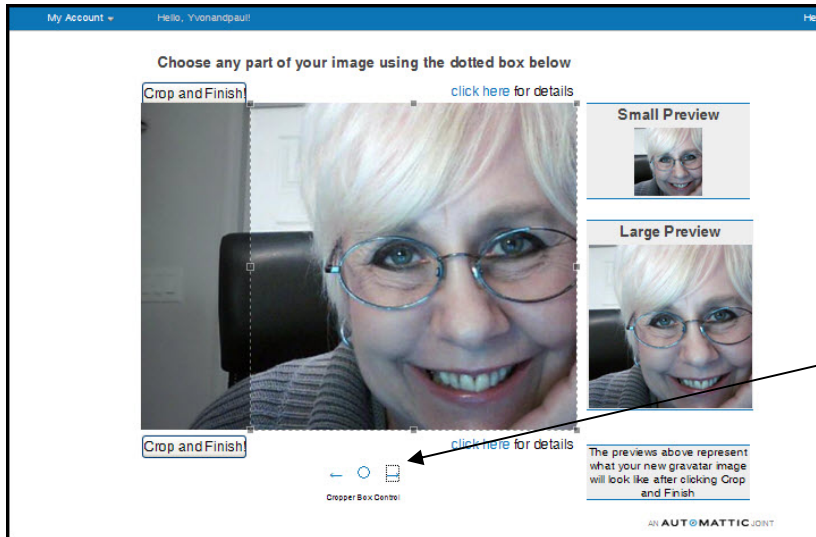
2. Enter an email address—  
\*\*be sure it is the same one you are using on your membership account. Gravatars are linked to email addresses.



3. It will go to this box where you choose where you want to get your image from.

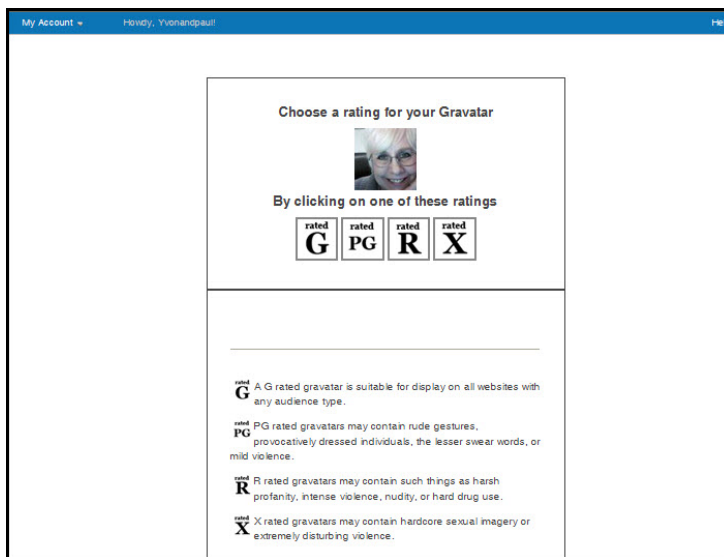


3. The one I chose was to get an image from the computer that I had already uploaded.  
4. You browse to find the file and then when you find it....  
5. Hit Next.



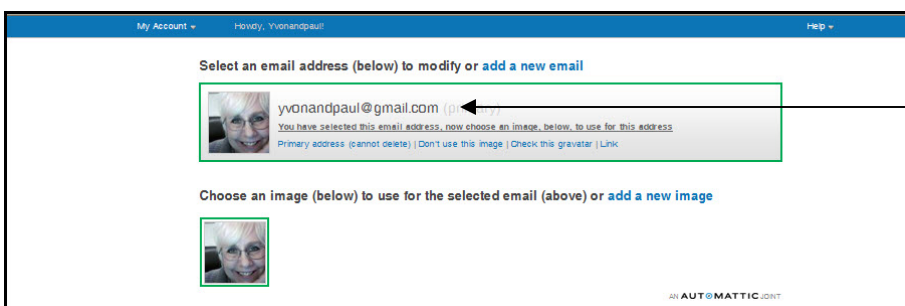
6. You will now be taken to a page where you can crop your image.

It's a little bit odd, because the crop tools are little and in a funny place, but here is where you move the cropping box.

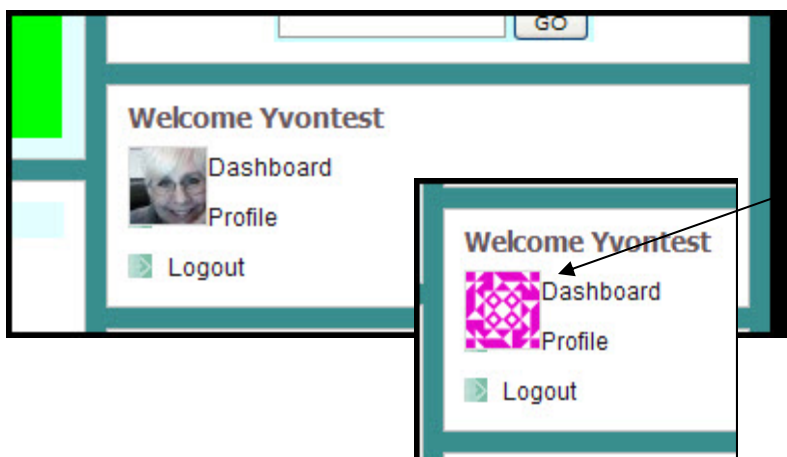


7. This is another strange thing, but I guess they have to have it. Choose the "rating" for your Gravatar.
