- Strategies to survive follow. . .



It's not about us

- We need multi-channel communication because our people vary in:
 - Access to technology
 - Finances
 - Literacy
 - Physical limitations
 - Skill level
 - Likes/dislikes
- · We are their servants & pastors

People Solutions

 - Don't make assumptions based on age!
 - In skills
 - Interest
 - Understanding

Print

- Still most accessible for many
- Instant access communication central
- LINK to all other multi-media through:
 - Church bulletin, inserts
 - Outreach postcards
 - Business/invitation cards



Print challenges

- Becoming one of the most expensive

- Look at alternate ways to print, consider
 - Digital duplicators for short term, throw-away
 - Online printers for fancy color
 - ***BUT YOU do the design***

- Useful for impact
- Expected in worship for many churches
- More limited than most imagine
 - ***PEOPLE DO NOT REMEMBER
 DETAILS from POWERPOINT***
- Also useful for teaching

Web

- Not optional—no longer impressive
- Just because you have one doesn't mean its useful
- MUST be up-to-date
- Opportunity to link for more information
 - In the church
 - Christian resources

Design is NOT what is most important

- Information is!
- Access is!
- Mobile phone access making some design useless and unnecessary
- Use a system that integrates with mobile phone access, e.g. WordPress
- TEST access!



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MUST to learn to do, modify your own

- One person updating can be a problem
- Strong recommendation: WordPress
- Learn to create a website with it, even the basics
- Won't be intimidated
- · Save lots of money



Email

- So basic.
- Expected
- Often misused
- DO NOT post email addresses if they are not answered !!!



Email newsletters, bulletins

- Can be tremendously effective
- Don't make them your only source of communication!
- Constant Contact & many more
 - \$15 a month for up to 500 on list, unlimited emails
 - www.constantcontact.com



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Social: Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, etc.

- Don't have them just to say you have them
- · Must have useful content
- One of the best pieces of advice in Social Boom
- Provide VALUE MESSAGES and people will connect with you.



The most important channel of all

- Your People!
 - Make everything successful
 - Destroy all other communications
- Inspire them
 - "What is the gospel according to you?"
- Equip them
 - Website, invitations, business cards, emails
- Check out what you do
 - Secret caller, visitor



The newest channel

- iPads and Tablet devices
- Kindles and e-readers
- "What will you do when an iPad costs \$40?"
- Don't let your excitement deceive you
