

How and why create an overall Church Information booklet and an ebook for Easter and all-year

If you want to get church guests to come back to your church after a visit at Easter or anytime, one of the best ways to do that is to create a booklet that gives visitors an overview of your church. This is especially important for holidays because churches seldom do the same things on Easter Sunday or other holiday times that they do the rest of the year. They do special things they don't normally do (brunch, Easter activities for children, special music) and they often don't do things they normall do, such as hold adult Bible classes.

In addition to the importance of knowing what your church does on a regular basis, visitors might be very interested in what you do in your church for children, youth, women, or various interest groups on an ongoing basis. You might announce these ministries during holiday services, but so much is going on at that time, it is easy for people to forget. In addition, you simply don't have time to tell people all about the activities and ministries that might be of great benefit to them.

Flyers and other handouts serve as temporary reminders, but a nice-looking booklet is a keeper. Families might toss it in a drawer, but if they feel a need for their kids or find themselves asking questions about God, they will pull it out and check out the church.

Make it useful for more than one occasion

Once you do up a booklet like the ones that follow, you can change the cover for different holidays or special occasions. In addition to changing the cover sure to stay up-to-date in the interior information as ministry events change.

Booklets like this are very easy to do in MS Publisher and with a little bit of adjusting the same booklet that works well to give away to visitors, can also be made into an ebook that you can post on your website and invite people to download and print out.

Following are three examples of church overview booklets. One is newer, two are older but all are EXCELLENT examples of the kind of information you need to include.


***ONE MORE IMPORTANT THING TO REMEMBER.....

Sunday morning services with Pastor Dan preaching live. The 11:30 service features the choir each week. For grades 1-5, graded Sunday School during the 9:00 service and children's church during the 11:30 service. Middle school meets during the message on the second and fourth Sundays during the 11:30 service.

VIDEO CAFÉ SERVICES SUNDAYS, 9:00 AM & 11:30 AM

Meeting in the auditorium on the west end of the building near Kids Cove, Video Café offers the more relaxed atmosphere of a coffee-house type venue. Live worship, "artsy" components, and Pastor Dan's message on live video feed. For grades 1-5, graded Sunday School during the 9:00 service and children's church during the 11:30 service. Under the leadership and preaching of Pastor Italo Gil, *Nueva Vida* (Spanish for New Life) conducts their weekly Hispanic worship service in the Kempsville auditorium on the west end of the building near Kids Cove.



Children's Ministry

Our nursery provides a loving, safe environment for the youngest children while their families participate in the worship service or other church activities.

At age three, children begin participating in age-appropriate classes and begin to build a firm foundation for their faith.

First graders move into the elementary program. Each service has a different look for these children. During the 9:00 AM services at Kempsville, children are dismissed to Sunday School classes following worship. Classes are divided into grades 1-2; grades 3-4; 5th grade boys; and 5th grade girls. On Saturday nights, and during the 11:30 Kempsville services and the Deep Creek service, the first through fifth graders are dismissed to a large group children's church. International Café has a separate children's ministry system—see a greeter for details. In all classes, our goal is to equip children with godly principles from the Bible and life application lessons.

Children also have opportunities for dance ministry, missions trips, and other special events. Adults have various opportunities to mentor or tutor at-risk children in our community outreach programs.

How can you get plugged in?

- Fill out a personal application and a request for a criminal history/sex offender record search. These are available in Kids Cove, Kids Creek, or the NLPC website.
- A personal interview with Pastor Cheryl to identify opportunities and placement.

Life Groups

New Life Providence believes that weekend worship services are essential to our life as a growing congregation. However, we also believe that small home groups— life groups—consisting of 5 to 15 people, are the foundational building block of the church. Life groups are the primary means through which personal ministry, pastoral care, discipleship, and leadership development occur in our congregation.

Groups typically meet three times a month for fellowship, study, prayer, and personal ministry. Some of our groups are also involved in outreach events to the community. Many groups are kid-friendly, while others are specifically designated for adults.

The life group display in the hall outside the Kempsville sanctuary is designed to help you find a group that fits you well. You'll find that the display is divided by the day of the week that groups meet, as well as sections specifically for women's and men's groups. - 5. New Life Providence is a small part of what God is doing worldwide in prayer.




children make it a night for the whole family.





We strive to accomplish this mission by implementing two main principles of operation: one-way traffic and reserved parking for Kids Cove.


In this way we can keep our most vulnerable attendees out of harm's way and minimize the delays, conflicts, and accidents that can adversely affect your approach to worship.


You can help us help you!

During our services, please:

- Observe one-way traffic pattern whether or not a parking attendant is in view.
- Refrain from parking in the Kids Cove reserved area unless you have a child to drop off in the nursery, whether or not a parking attendant is in view.
- ♦ Do not speed.
- Pull into a parking spot instead of backing up when there are cars behind you.
- Use your turn signals so others know how to anticipate your movements.
- ♦ Do not text-message while driving!
- When walking across the roadway, keep your group together and go directly across.
- Stay out of handicap parking spaces unless you have a disabled person in your car.
- ♦ Ask a parking attendant for help if you have a need for special consideration contrary to the traffic pattern in effect.

Providence Code Breaker

Every group, over time, develops its own specialized vocabulary. Athletes, musicians, and politicians all have insider phrases, but so do church members. Here are some of the codes at New Life Providence (NLP):



Transethnic – a word that is not in the dictionary, but we use to mean "moving beyond (*trans*) our cultural and ethnic backgrounds to a culture of full partnership and mutual respect in the kingdom of God"

Soaking – a type of prayer where you rest in the Lord's presence rather than filling your prayer time with a lot of words

Other Providence prayer terms:

King's Chamber – A prayer meeting incorporating worship and intercession in a style described in Revelation 5:7-9. Some churches call this "harp and bowl."

Refuge Prayer – Also known as altar ministry, this is an appropriate place for you to bring personal prayer concerns.

Month of Prayer – Each year August is designated as the month of prayer for NLP. Our normal church schedule is set aside for this powerful prayer emphasis.

Life Group (cell group) – a small group of 5 to 15 people who meet weekly to share their lives together

Kids Cove – the children's ministry headquarters at the west end of the Kempsville building (toward Thompkins Lane)

Kids Creek – the children's ministry headquarters at the north end of the Deep Creek campus

Kids Hope – a national program to match adult mentors with student mentorees. We have about 75 adults working with students at Thurgood Marshall Elementary School under Pastor Cheryl Muniz.

PJ/52 or Project/52 is the name of our youth program.

Terms used within the youth program:

The Door – service for middle school and high school students on Saturday nights Core – small groups for high schoolers that meet on Wednesday nights

Awake – the name of our young adult ministry, ages 18 to 28 Other Awake terms:

823 – a weekly gathering of young adults for worship, ministry, and fellowship.

LEC = Life Enrichment Center, an urban outreach ministry in Norfolk led by Pastor Kevin Turpin

Primetime – the classroom-based equipping program for adults (primarily midweek, with a few classes offered at other times)

Discovery – a two-part seminar all new members are required to attend

NLMI = New Life Ministries International. This is the group of churches New Life Providence belongs to.

Some NLMI terms:

NLSOM = New Life School of Missions, a training program for those called to missions, offered to all New Life churches

CMC = Church Multiplication Center, a program for training leaders for church plants, church expansions, etc.

Video Café – a Sunday service that has live worship and a video sermon in a coffee house ambiance with an arts emphasis

Arts Café – an event facilitated by Video Café that occurs about once a month on a weekend. Each evening event offers freshly prepared gourmet food and a program with an arts emphasis.

International Café – a Sunday service that caters to those from other nations and others with a heart for internationals.

Meet and Greet – this is a 4-minute transition time right before the sermon used to casually visit with others.

Nueva Vida – a Spanish-speaking church that hold its services in the NLP Kempsville auditorium

PPUMC (Park Place United Methodist Church) and **Judeo Christian Outreach Center** are two local centers for outreach to homeless and the needy. **PIN** (People in Need) is another local ministry reaching out to the needy. NLP regularly works with these programs in outreach activity.

Leadership Huddle – a gathering of NLP leaders occurring approximately once a month during the school year


