- Black on white, easiest to read because of:
- High Contrast
- Dark blue, brown, green can also work

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Use pastels with care

White background with spot color best for seasonal







Ink-based vs. toner-based reproduction

- Ink-based: ink-jet printer, digital duplicator, offset on uncoated paper
 - Color sinks in and mixes with the paper color
 - ALWAYS test colors, expect some changes
- Toner-based: laser printers, copiers, some digital production machines
 - Toner sits on top of the paper
 - Colors tend to be more accurate



How to select text color

• Pick a color from image used





Options: all readable

- Contrast the key
- Select for audience and budget







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
